Fellow Association Members,

Association management and I have recently become aware of an issue regarding on-street parking interfering with refuse removal. If a vehicle is blocking access by Waste Management Inc. (WMI) vehicles, WMI will not pick up in the affected area. This has been verified with WMI and Sarasota County office of Contract Compliance. This also holds true for the delivery of mail at curbside mailboxes.

This problem seems to be most prevalent in the cul-de-sacs of our community, not so much in the sub associations. Vehicles are being parked around the circles and blocking the access of the WMI recycling trucks to the recycling cans.

Since we know that refuse collection takes place on Thursdays (or in the case of a holiday, the following Friday) could we all refrain from on street parking on Thursday until refuse collection is over for the day. If we observe a neighbor or contractor parking in a location that could cause WMI to bypass a street for collection on that day, a polite reminder will help ensure that trash collection would not be interrupted.

A remarkably simple solution to resolve the problem, however, the **compliance and fining process** will proceed if the services of WMI continue to be interrupted.

This would also prevent us from having to put a refuse container full of trash away for another week.
