Two final Issues

Fellow Association Members,

I had planned that the October Presidents Message was to be my last, but a serious issue has developed that we as a community need to be aware of.

On Monday November 8th between 7am and 9am our community was “visited” by persons who were stealing outgoing mail from mailboxes. This event was reported to the Sarasota County Sheriff’s Office and to the United States Postal Service Postal Inspectors Office for further investigation. The thieves were driving through the community looking for mailboxes with the flag raised and then taking what was inside the box.

This raises two concerns: First if you had an outgoing bill with a check, the thieves now have a check with your personal information on it to use as they wish. Secondly, with the holidays upon us, there will be more mail and packages being delivered to mailboxes and porches providing an opportunity for thieves.

If you believe that you have had either outgoing or delivered mail stolen report it immediately to the Sarasota County Sheriff’s Office and the USPS Postal Inspectors office. Also contact your financial institution for guidance on how to proceed in case your financial information was compromised.

Again, should you observe any suspicious activity call the Sheriff's Office immediately. Doing this will help deter theft in our community. Let's all look out for each other this Holiday Season.
